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# Courses offered at Madrasatu Banaatil Islaam

 A Five Year Full-Time Aalimah Course.

Together with the above-mentioned course, students also complete the following:

- Cooking and Baking
- Sewing
- Handcrafts
- Ustâdhs training

A specific time of the day is set aside wherein students are advised regarding good conduct and morals. The educators themselves take on this responsibility of nurturing the students.

Students are also given the opportunity to revise various aspects of character with their colleagues. On certain occasions we are graced with the presence of our local senior Ulamâ as well as visiting jamâ'ats to convey some of their advices to the students.



The Nurturing of Students is our prime objective at the Madrasatu Banaatills laam, to such an extent that if a child does not excelather studies but leaves the madrasah with good qualities, character and an Islamic way of life, then we have indeed a chieved

### The Facilities of Madrasatu Banaatil Islaam

The structure and design of the Madrasatu Banaatil Islaam promotes the laws of Hijâb, whereby there is *no intermingling between male and female staff members.* 

Females have their entrance which is completely separate to that of the males.

Male teachers conduct their lessons from behind a partitioning.



The Madrasah has a *library* consisting of Islamic literature which students utilize for research purposes.

They are also provided with photocopying facilities on the premises.

Our **sewing and crafts class** is equipped with sewing machines, overlockers and a cutting table.

\* Dedicated volunteers assist in the training of the students.





To facilitate the **cooking and baking courses**, the Madrasah boasts a fully fitted kitchen with stoves, ovens, fridge and microwave oven.

\* These courses are all offered by dedicated volunteers from our community.

A spacious **ablution block** with sufficient wudhu and toilet facilities compliments the comfort in which students are able to study.



Other Activities and Projects of Madrasatu Banaatil Islaam



The Madrasah offers a 1 year Tarbiyat / Gap year course for all those wanting to improve and enhance their basic knowledge of Islâm.

These students attend classes weekly and are taught various subjects.

### 2. Transport:

Those Aalimah students living at a distance are transported daily to and from the Madrasah. This service is subsidised by the Madrasah and ensures that students travel safely and supervised to Madrasah.

# 3. Underprivileged students:

Those students coming from poor or underprivileged households are exempted from all fees at the madrasah. Their needs at the madrasah are taken care of leaving them with only having to concentrate on their studies.

We at Madrasatu Banaatil Islaam endeavour to take Deen to the people, making it easy for them to attain the awareness of the Almighty.
