MAKE GARMENTS 123632 (20 credits)

The qualifying learner is capable of:

- Cutting out garment parts using a commercial pattern.
- Preparing the workplace and setting the sewing machine.
- Sewing, finishing and pressing the garment.
- Checking the quality of the completed garment.

COST A GARMENT 123631 (4 credits)

The qualifying learner is capable of:

- Identifying components and materials required to make a garment.
- Calculating quantities.
- Costing the garment and calculating selling price.
- Evaluating and adjusting the costing and / or selling price according to customer requirements and market demands.
