



This page highlights cases seen at the White Door Centre

Traumatized client seeking counselling after being drugged and gangraped. Ongoing counselling support was offered to the client as well as family members who felt unable to handle the client's trauma.

Fearful mother seeking assistance and shelter after escaping an abusive situation which culminated in her stabbing her partner. The client was severely traumatized after discovering her child was being sexually abused by her partner, triggering memories of her own abusive childhood.

Young female approached the White Door Centre for counselling. The client was burdened with the responsibility of rearing her younger siblings as both her parents were substance abusers. Client recounts the fear of having friends visit and find her mother drunkenly verbally abusing her. Growing up, there was no support extended to her by other family members, leaving the client to deal with the shame and cope alone.

Client brought to the centre by a family member for grief counselling. The client was withdrawn after discovering the body of a family member who died from unnatural causes and was struggling to come to terms with this.

Distraught mother of 2 seeking assistance after her children were trafficked out of the region. Threats to the wellbeing of her children was allegedly used to coerce her into agreeing to a short stay that was then extended after which the children were moved to an unknown location.

Depressed female referred to the White Door Centre. The client was experiencing the fallout of an abusive relationship in which she was constantly humiliated publicly and blackmailed by her partner, thus making it extremely difficult for her to terminate the relationship.

Client assisted at the White Door with counselling for multiple issues, including multiple suicide attempts, which were pleas for help to other family members; to no avail. The client suffered severe depression and anxiety compounded by unemployment.

Victim experiencing severe post traumatic disorder after being caught in the middle of a gang shoot out in a crowded public space and unable to escape. The intense trauma and prolonged exposure to life threatening violence, compounded by the helplessness of being trapped, convinced of imminent death, has led to deep psychological scars.

Client referred to SAPS after being verbally and physically assaulted by a family member. The client was kicked several times in the lower abdomen and slapped. The abuser openly displayed no remorse or concern about their behaviour, nor did they feel that their own abuse of substances was a matter of concern.

Concerned parents requiring counselling and a referral for their son, an alleged addict. The clients reported being subjected to verbal and physical abuse at the hands of their adult son, who refuses to seek help for his addiction.

WHY YOUR SUPPORT MATTERS

The Eastern Cape is in the grip of a humanitarian crisis. Over 72% of its population lives in poverty, with child malnutrition affecting nearly 1 in 3 children under five. Stunted growth, chronic food insecurity, and an unemployment rate exceeding 42% reflect a region battling systemic neglect and socio, economic exclusion.

But where there is crisis, there is also the call to act.

Founded in 2008, Al-Fidaa Foundation stands at the frontline, transforming statistics into stories of change. While our roots are in the Eastern Cape, our impact now stretches nationally through scalable skills training, food security, and empowerment programs that rebuild livelihoods.


